(TODDINGTON: PART OF FOOTPATH NO 21)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2016

Notice is hereby given that the Order made by Central Bedfordshire Council on the 11 July 2016 the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along the length of Footpath No 21, Toddington which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0052 2929 (Map point A) to OS GR TL 0057 2959 (Map point B) has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 15 January 2018.

This temporary closure is required to enable a new fence and trench to be constructed in association with excavation works. The closure is expected to continue from 15 July 2017 for up to six months.

The alternative routes for Footpath users while the closure is in operation will be signed locally.

The Order will continue in force until 15 January 2018 or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
