(CRANFIELD: FOOTPATH NO 46)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 200



Notice is hereby given that the Order made by Central Bedfordshire Council on the 20 August 2018 the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along the length of Footpath No 46, Cranfield which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) SP 9526 4154 (Map point B) in a south easterly direction for approximately 152 metres to OS GR SP 9540 4148 (Map point A) has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 28 February 2019.

This closure is required to allow for development works to take place . The closure is expected to continue from 28 August 2018 to 28 February 2019.

There is no alternative route for footpath users while the closure is in operation.

The Order will continue in force until 28 February 2019 or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
