ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL

(BIGGLESWADE: PARTS OF FOOTPATH NO 39 AND BRIDLEWAY NOS 57 AND 69)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2016

Notice is hereby given that the Order made by Central Bedfordshire Council on the 12 September 2016 the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along the length of Footpath No 39, Biggleswade which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR ) TL 2086 4353 (Map point C) to OS GR TL 2096 4327 (Map point F) and on foot or on horseback or lead a horse or cycle along the length of Bridleway No 57, Biggleswade which extends from OS GR TL 2120 4375 (Map point F) to OS GR TL 2115 4381 (Map point H) and Bridleway No 69, Biggleswade which extends from OS GR TL 2082 4369 (Map point A) to OS GR TL 2118 4378 (Map point B) has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 15 September 2018.

**These temporary closures are required to enable development ground works to be carried out in safety. The closures are expected to continue from 16 March 2017 for up to eighteen months.**

There are no alternative routes for footpath and bridleway users while the closures are in operation.

The Order will continue in force until 15 September 2018 or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within eighteen months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
