ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

(HOUGHTON REGIS: BRIDLEWAY 49)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 200

Notice is hereby given that the Order made by Central Bedfordshire Council on 25 June 2018 to the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot, horseback or lead a horse or cycle along the full length of Bridleway 49, Houghton Regis has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 16 January 2019 .

This temporary closure is required to enable heavy plant movement around the bridleway safely. The closure is expected to take place from 16 July 2018 to 16 January 2019.

There is no alternative route for this closure.

The Order will continue in force until 16 January 2019 or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within eighteen months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
