(HOUGHTON REGIS: BRIDLEWAY NO 49)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2017

Notice is hereby given that the Order made by Central Bedfordshire Council on the 10 July 2017 the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot or on horseback or lead a horse or cycle along the full length of Bridleway No 49, Houghton Regis which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0007 2378 (Map point A) to OS GR SP 9994 2448 (Map point B) has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 16 July 2018.

This temporary closure is required to enable works associated with the new Highways depot, waste recycling centre and access road to be carried out in safety. The closure is expected to continue from 16 January 2018 for six months.

There is no alternative route for Bridleway users while the closure is in operation.

The Order will continue in force until 16 July 2018 or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
