(MEPPERSHALL: PART OF FOOTPATH NO 4)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2017

Notice is hereby given that the Order made by Central Bedfordshire Council on the 8 May 2017 the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along the length of Footpath No 4, Meppershall which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 1391 3689 (Map point A) to OS GR TL 1394 3685 (Map point B) has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 18 May 2018.

This temporary closure is required to enable surfacing works to be carried out in safety. The closure is expected to continue from 18 November 2017 for approximately three months.

The alternative route for footpath users while the closure is in operation will be along the gravel footpath laid out on site and shown on the Order map.

The Order will continue in force until 18 May 2018 or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
