(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2017

W H E R E A S Central Bedfordshire Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) being the Highway Authority for public Bridleway No 28 is satisfied that through traffic in the said bridleway should be restricted by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon or near thereto

N O W T H E R E F O R E the Council in exercise of their powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall proceed on foot or on horseback or lead a horse or cycle for a period of six months along the length of public Bridleway No 28, Biggleswade which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference TL 2058 4525 to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference TL 2064 4529.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 2017 and may be cited as “The Central Bedfordshire Council (Biggleswade: Part of Bridleway No 28) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 2017”
