(ASPLEY HEATH: PART OF BYWAY OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC NO 27)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2017

Notice is hereby given that Central Bedfordshire Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot or on horseback or lead a horse or cycle or motor cycle or drive a motor vehicle along the length of Byway Open to All Traffic No 27, Aspley Heath which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) SP 9299 3543 (Map point A) to OS GR SP 9287 3512 (Map point B).

This temporary closure is required to enable works to be carried out on the Byway. The closure is expected to take place from 26 September 2017 for up to 3 weeks. Access will be maintained for bin collections on Mondays.

There is no alternative route for Byway users while the closure is in operation.

The Order will come into operation on 25 September 2017 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the Bridleway have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
