ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)

CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL

(LANGFORD: PART OF BRIDLEWAY NO 4 AND ARLESEY: PART OF BRIDLEWAY NO 9)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2017

Notice is hereby given that Central Bedfordshire Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot or on horseback or lead a horse or cycle along the length of Bridleway No 4 Langford which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 2051 3887 in a generally southerly direction for approximately 304 metres to OS GR TL 2054 3857 and the length of Bridleway No 9 Arlesey which extends from OS GR TL 2054 3857 south westerly for approximately 7 metres to OS GR TL 2054 3857.

These temporary closures are required to enable repairs to the bridge. The closure is expected to take place from 26 February until 31 March 2018.

There is no alternative route for bridleway users while the closure is in operation.

The Order will come into operation on 26 February 2018 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the Bridleways have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
