(EGGINGTON: PART OF FOOTPATH NO 6)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2018

Notice is hereby given that Central Bedfordshire Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along that part of Public Footpath no. 6, Eggington running from its junction with Leighton Buzzard Public Footpath no. 65 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) SP 9401 2534 (Map point A) for a distance of approximately 520 metres in a generally easterly direction to OS GR SP 9453 2538 (Map point B).

This temporary closure is required to enable infrastructure works relating to development to take place. The closure is expected to take place from 31 August 2018 to 01 March 2019.

The alternative route for footpath users while the closure is in operation will be laid out and signed on site but will generally follow the route shown on the map.

The proposed Order will come into operation on 31 August 2018 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the Footpath have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
