(PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO 11, AMPHILL)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2018

Notice is hereby given that Central Bedfordshire Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along the length of Footpath No 11, Ampthill, which extends from its junction with Footpath 12 at approximately Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0235 3840 (map point A) for a distance of approximately 750 metres in a generally easterly direction to its junction with Footpaths 13, 32 and an unaffected section of 11 at approximately Ordnance Survey Grid reference (OS GR) TL SP 0310 3840 (map point B)

This temporary closure is required as the legal route of public footpath No 11 which forms part of the Greensand Ridge Walk, will be affected by the perimeter fence installed for the ampthill festival event. The closure is expected to take place from Monday 25th June to Tuesday 3rd July, both dates inclusive.

The alternative route for footpath users is within the park alongside the festival fence.

The proposed Order will come into operation on for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the Footpath have been completed, whichever is the earlier.

If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
