	800m south-west of Elstow conservation area, which contains a number of listed buildings. 1km south of the scheduled remains of Elstow Manor and Moot Hall.
	2km north-east of the scheduled moat at Kempston Hardwick.
Proximity to active waste site	Same site as Elstow North Materials Recovery and Transfer facility. Adjacent to Elstow Landfill site (partly restored) which produces electricity through landfill gas turbines.
