

Application for a school place for 2018

This application form is for parents and carers with parental responsibility who live within Central Bedfordshire and would like to apply for a place in September 2018 for one of the following admission rounds:

- Transfer to Upper 2018 Closing date 31 October 2017
- Transfer to Secondary 2018 Closing date 31 October 2017
- Transfer to Middle 2018 Closing date 15 January 2018
- Starting School 2018 Closing date 15 January 2018

The closing dates are nationally set by the Department for Education and apply to all Admissions Teams throughout the country.

If you live in another local authority do not complete this form. You must complete your home local authority's application form and return it to them.

Important things to consider before applying

- Make sure your application reaches us by the national closing date! All applications we receive after the national closing date will be classed as late and not processed until the late allocation round, which will take place after the national offer day for on time applications. Late applications are not dealt with until after all the on time applications have been considered. Places are not reserved at schools in the on time allocation for late catchment children or any other circumstances.
- Submitting a late application significantly reduces your child's chance of an offer of a place at one of your preferred schools.
- Consider other local schools for your application in case a place cannot be offered at your first preference school.
- Living in the catchment area may give your child priority however it does not automatically guarantee a place at your local school.
- Be realistic about the schools you are applying for.
- If you live outside the catchment area and have an older child at the school, we cannot guarantee your younger child will be offered a place at the same school.
- You will find out where your child has been offered a school place on:
 - Transfer to Upper/Secondary 1 March 2018
 - Starting School/ Transfer to Middle 16 April 2018
- If a place cannot be offered at your preferred school(s), the Council will offer a place at a suitable school in the local area.
- Consider whether you would be eligible for free home to school transport; a parent's guide to home to school transport is attached to this application form which will provide information on this.
- All the information you may need to make your application is available on our website <u>www.centralbedfordshire.gov.uk/admissions</u> or by contacting the School Admissions Team.

For Starting School 2018 applications only

- You must include proof of your child's date of birth, with your application. Please send a copy of your child's passport or short birth certificate to the school Admissions Team when you make your application.
- Even if your child attends a nursery or preschool on the school site, you must still make a Starting School 2018 application to the School Admissions Team as there is no automatic transfer to Reception Year.
- Having a place at the nursery or preschool does not guarantee your child a place in Reception Year.

Parent's Guide to Home to School Transport

Central Bedfordshire Council currently provides transport assistance to pupils who meet certain criteria as set out in the Council's current Home to School Transport Policy, full details of which can be found on the Council's website:

www.centralbedfordshire.gov.uk/schooltransport.

A brief overview of the criteria is given below:

Pupils attending mainstream schools

For pupils attending a mainstream school, transport assistance may be provided if they meet one of the following criteria:

- Pupils aged 5 8 years old (up to the end of year 3) who live more than the statutory walking distance of 2 miles, by the shortest available walking route to their nearest school.
- Pupils aged 8 16 years old (years 4 11) who live more than the statutory walking distance of 3 miles by the shortest available walking route, to their nearest school.

The statutory walking distance may not apply where the route which the pupil would be expected to walk to their nearest school (when accompanied by an appropriate adult) is assessed as unsafe.

Pupils with special educational needs

Having a current statement of special educational needs or an Education Health Care Plan (EHCP) does not guarantee transport. However transport may be provided if:

- The pupil is attending the nearest mainstream school and meets the distance criteria stated above
- The pupil is attending the nearest special school with spaces available which meets the distance criteria stated above and has been identified by the Council as being able to appropriately meet their needs.

Low income families

Pupils from low income families may be entitled to transport assistance. The pupil will be entitled if they are eligible for free school meals.

They must also meet one of the criteria below:

- Pupils aged between 8 11 who attend the nearest or designated catchment school and the distance between home and school is over 2 miles by the shortest available walking route.
- Pupils aged between 11 16 (Years 7-11) who attend 1 of the 3 nearest appropriate schools between 2 – 6 miles from the home address by the shortest walking route if up to 3 miles or the shortest motorised route if over 3 miles.

Concessionary travel

When there is a Council operated school bus with spare seats available after all entitled pupils have been offered places, the Council may sell these as concessions. They are sold on a first come, first served basis, one term at a time and being accepted for a place for one term does not guarantee a place for the next term.
