## Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

Definitive Map and Statement for the Excluded Fully Developed Area of Central Biggleswade in Central Bedfordshire

CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT FOR THE FORMER EXCLUDED FULLY DEVELOPED AREA OF CENTRAL BIGGLESWADE) (BIGGLESWADE: FOOTPATHS NOS E29, E30, E31, E33, E36, E37 and E39) MODIFICATION ORDER 2017

The above Order made on 3 March 2017, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the former excluded fully developed area of central Biggleswade by adding to them a number of lengths of footpath and bridleway – as described in the full order available on the Council's website at: <a href="http://www.centralbedfordshire.gov.uk/leisure/countryside/definitive-map/biggleswade.aspx">http://www.centralbedfordshire.gov.uk/leisure/countryside/definitive-map/biggleswade.aspx</a> and summarised below:

Footpath No E29 Biggleswade (South Walk) extends from its junction with Drove Road between Nos. 126 and 128 east-north-eastwards along South Walk for approximately 190 metres to its junction with Rowan Crescent adjacent to No. 52. The footpath continues from its junction with Rowan Crescent adjacent to No. 41 along South Walk in an east-north-easterly direction for approximately 41 metres to terminate at the garage complex adjacent to No. 6 South Walk

<u>Footpath No E30 Biggleswade</u> extends from its junction with Footpath No. E29 South Walk opposite No. 1 in a west-north-westerly and then a north-easterly direction for approximately 42 metres through a garage complex to terminate at its junction with Glebe Road between Nos. 6 and 8.

<u>Footpath No E31 Biggleswade</u> extends from its junction with Footpath No. E29 adjacent to No. 1 South Walk in a north-north-west direction for approximately 35 metres to terminate at its junction with Glebe Road between Nos. 22 and 24.

<u>Footpath No E33 Biggleswade</u> extends from its junction with Footpath No. E29 South Walk adjacent to No. 6 in a north-north-westerly direction for approximately 34 metres along an alleyway to terminate at its junction with Glebe Road between Nos. 28a and 30.

<u>Footpath No E36 Biggleswade (East Walk)</u> extends from its junction with Glebe Road between Nos. 11 and 13 in a north-north-westerly direction for approximately 26 metres along East Walk to terminate at its junction with another part of East Walk adjacent to No.10

<u>Footpath No E37 Biggleswade</u> extends from its junction with Bellingham Place adjacent to No. 3 in a north-north-westerly and then continues in a west-north-westerly direction for approximately 71 metres to terminate at its junction with Drove Road between Nos. 178 and 182.

<u>Footpath No E39 Biggleswade</u> extends from its junction with Rowan Crescent between Nos. 14 and 16 in a north-westerly direction for approximately 65 metres to terminate at its junction with the service road to Drove Road between Nos. 86 and 88.

Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to the Definitive Map Officer, Rights of Way Team, Central Bedfordshire Council, Priory House, Monks Walk,

Chicksands, Shefford, SG17 5QT not later than **5 May 2017**, and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made. Representations and objections must include either a postal or e-mail address. **Any representations or objections made will be in the public domain and will be available for viewing/copying by members of the public.** 

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn the Central Bedfordshire Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order and will be made publicly available by either the Council or the Planning Inspectorate.
