Central Bedfordshire Council Notice of Making of Public Path Order Highways Act 1980

CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (HENLOW: PART OF FOOTPATH NO 8) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2016

The above Order made on 23 September 2016 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert Footpath No 8, Henlow as shown on the Order map.

The length of Footpath No 8, Henlow to be stopped up extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 1849 3785 (Map point A) in an easterly direction for approximately 62 metres to its junction with Footpath No 7, Henlow at OS GR TL1855 3786 (Map point B).

The length of Footpath No 8, Henlow to be created extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 1849 3785 (Map point A) in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 13 metres to OS GR 1849 3786 (Map point C) and then continues in an easterly direction for approximately 57 metres to its junction with Footpath No 7, Henlow at OS GR TL 1855 3787 (Map point D).

The new route of the footpath has a width of 3.0 metres

Please state the grounds on which they are made. Representations and objections must include either a postal or e-mail address. Any representations or objections made will be in the public domain and will be available for viewing/copying by members of the public.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn the Central Bedfordshire Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order and will be made publicly available by either the Council or the Planning Inspectorate.
