It is an offence knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement
in connection with an application, the maximum fine of which a
person is liable on summary conviction is a level 5 fine on the
standard scale.

GUIDANCE FOR PREMISES NOTICE

The notice for display on your premises must be printed on light blue paper of at least A4 size. It must be printed/typed legibly in black ink in a font of at least 16.

The notice should be placed prominently at or on the premises to which the application relates where it can be conveniently read from the exterior of the premises. In the case of a premises covering an area of more than 50 square metres, a further identical notice must be placed every 50 metres along the external perimeter of the premises abutting any highway.

A copy of the notice and newspaper advert should be forwarded to the licensing department.
