4. Update on planning applications received

Site 1 – Full application approved subject to s106 agreement. Additional condition to be included. Additional condition refers to Chapter 9 of the Master Plan and aims to secure the provision of infrastructure at appropriate times.

Site 3 – As Site 1 but with additional condition re: site traffic 5 Way Junction – Currently negotiating possible revised junction design Site 7,8,9 – Still under negotiation

Questions:

Highways Application current out to consultation, why?

This is not a planning consultation and it has been raised with officers as to why
it has gone out to consultation. The planning application will need to go through
the planning process and be reviewed at CBC Development Management
Committee (DMC)

5 Way Junction app. Is the application compliant with existing or previous parking standards?

- New application potentially has more parking available

Will more school places be made available?

- A new lower school will be provided within the Arlesey East development. The Pix Brook Academy will provide new middle and upper school places
- Is there any news on the Green King site?
 - Negotiations are now taking place with neighboring land owners.

5. Land to the East of the High Street, Arlesey

Road Application – consultation period largely completed. Aim to have the application considered at DMC at end of May.

Main Site – Public consultation still open (statutory consultation has closed). Hope to respond to the majority of concerns and depending on level of response hope to have considered at DMC in June.

Bridge Application – designs near completion and hope to submit formal application by mid May.

Questions:

Masterplan – Gas main not being noted in original plan has meant that the master plan is not able to be delivered. ATC voiced their frustration at the impact on level of employment. Also concern over number of parking spaces and possible impact on employment opportunities.

- Up to 950 houses indicated in the outline plan. This is to provide a wide variety of homes. Planners will review the plan and negotiate best land use taking into

	account the masterplan. Road timescale? - Plan to start works at end of 2017 and anticipated to take 10 months. Archeology to start as soon as possible. Request for support with regards to water management. - CBC requested to encourage owners of Site 1 to co-operate with Telereal Trillium in order to best manage water.
