Attention Autism (Gina Davies Autism Centre) - £150*

Thursday 28 September & 5 October 2017, 09:30 - 16:30 at the Rufus Centre, Flitwick This two day course equips attendees with the skills to set up and run the 4 Stage Attention Autism programme. The training focuses on the practical aspects of intervention, working in a team and offering an irresistible invitation to learn. The Attention Autism programme targets the teaching of attention, communication and social interaction skills. There are demonstrations of the techniques in action, films of the work with children, practical handson experience for participants and ideas for activities.

We have added these new e-learning courses recently:

Sensory Processing Skills (NDNA) Book here

This online course has been developed in partnership with specialist children's therapists, EQUIP. It will provide insight and strategies for managing children with adverse behaviours, such as biting. If a child has a problem developing their sensory processing skills, it has a huge effect on their behaviour.

Visual Perceptual Skills (NDNA) Book here

This online course has been developed in partnership with specialist children's therapists, EQUIP. It looks at visual perception skills and how these impact on a child's development. The training identifies difficulties and warning signs and promotes strategies to help children with visual perception skills.

Promoting Positive Behaviour (NDNA) Book here

Behaviour is learnt, but it is also a product of the environment. Behaviour can be considered as a form of communication. NDNA's online course will give practitioners the skills to promote good behaviour in young children. It will also help you interpret and correctly address challenging behaviours, such as tantrums, biting and not sharing.

The United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (NDNA) Book here

This online course will support all practitioners working with children to understand the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC). You will gain knowledge and practical ideas about examining particular UNCRC articles relevant to the early years community, how the UNCRC links with current early years legislation, discovering the difference between wants and needs and finally learn how to embed children's rights into everyday practice.

Mini Maths Explorers: Outdoor Challenge (NDNA) Book here

This NDNA online course will help you link every outdoor situation to learning about numbers, shape, space and measure but keeping it fun at the same time! Course key topics:

- The weather and other natural resources
- Going to the park, the beach, or the woods
- Mud check out the chapter on Mini Mud Mathematics
- Using bikes and trikes to understand maths in motion
- Audit tools and action plan templates.
