CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (CHALTON: PART OF FOOTPATH NO 7) PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2018

The above Order made on 6 July 2018 under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 will extinguish part of Footpath No 7, Chalton as shown on the Order map.

That length of Footpath No 7, Chalton to be stopped up extends from its junction with the Woodside Link road at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0376 2572 (Order map – point A) in a generally east south easterly direction for approximately 77 metres to OS GR TL 0383 2569 (Order map – point B) and then continues in a south south westerly direction for approximately 209 metres to OS GR TL 0377 2550 and then continues in a southerly direction for approximately 76 metres to OS GR TL 0377 2542 and then continues in a south easterly and then generally south westerly direction for approximately 138 metres to its junction with another part of the Woodside Link road at OS GR TL 0372 2533 (Order map – point C).

The footpath is stopped up over its full width.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of Central Bedfordshire Council Highways, Priory House, Monks Walk, Chicksands, Shefford between 9.00am and 5.00pm on Mondays to Thursdays and between 9.00am to 4.00pm on Fridays. Copies of the Order and map may be bought there at a charge of £4.00. An explanatory statement can be obtained by phoning 0300 300 6888. Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Senior LSG Officer, Central Bedfordshire Council Highways, Priory House, Monks Walk, Chicksands, Shefford, SG17 5QT not later than 17 August 2018. Please state the grounds on which they are made. Representations and objections must include either a postal or e-mail address. Any representations or objections made will be in the public domain and will be available for viewing/copying by members of the public.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn the Central Bedfordshire Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order and will be made publicly available by either the Council or the Planning Inspectorate.
