Notice of Confirmation of Public Path Order
Highways Act 1980

CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (STOTFOLD: PART OF FOOTPATH NO 7) PUBLIC PATH CREATION ORDER 2016

On the 1 July 2016 Central Bedfordshire Council confirmed the above Order made under Section 26 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to create the following length of public Footpath No 7, Stotfold as shown on the Order map.

That length of Footpath No 7, Stotfold to be created extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 2194 3769 (Map point E) in a north easterly direction for approximately 5 metres across the agricultural access track to OS GR TL 2194 3769 (Map Point F) where it has a junction with another part of Footpath No 7, Stotfold.

The new length of footpath has a width of 1.8 metres

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of Rights of Way Team, Central Bedfordshire Council, Priory House, Monks Walk, Chicksands, Shefford SG17 5QT between 9.00am and 5.00pm Mondays to Thursdays and between 9.00am to 4.00pm Fridays. Copies of the Order and map may be bought there at a charge of £4.00.

The Order comes into force on 8 July 2016, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 8 July 2016 make an application to the High Court.
