CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (STOTFOLD: PART OF FOOTPATH NO 7) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2016

On the 1 July 2016 Central Bedfordshire Council confirmed the above Order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the following length of public Footpath No 7, Stotfold as shown on the Order map.

The length of Footpath No 7, Stotfold to be stopped up extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 2192 3767 (Map point B) in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 139 metres to its junction with Taylors Road at OS GR TL 2180 3774 (Map point A).

The length of Footpath No 7, Stotfold to be created extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR)TL 2193 3768 (Map point D) in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 147 metres to its junction with Aspen Gardens and Taylors Road at OS GR TL 2181 3757 (Map point C).

The new route of the footpath has a width of 1.8 metres

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of Rights of Way Team, Central Bedfordshire Council, Priory House, Monks Walk, Chicksands, Shefford SG17 5QT between 9.00am and 5.00pm Mondays to Thursdays and between 9.00am to 4.00pm Fridays. Copies of the Order and map may be bought there at a charge of £4.00.

The Order comes into force on 8 July 2016, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 8 July 2016 make an application to the High Court.
