Suggested Assessment of First Aid Needs Checklist

The **minimum** First Aid requirements for an event site are normally:

· A suitably marked and stocked First Aid Container

Do you have peripatetic or lone workers?

- An Appointed Person to be responsible for the First Aid arrangements
- Information to employees on the First Aid arrangements
