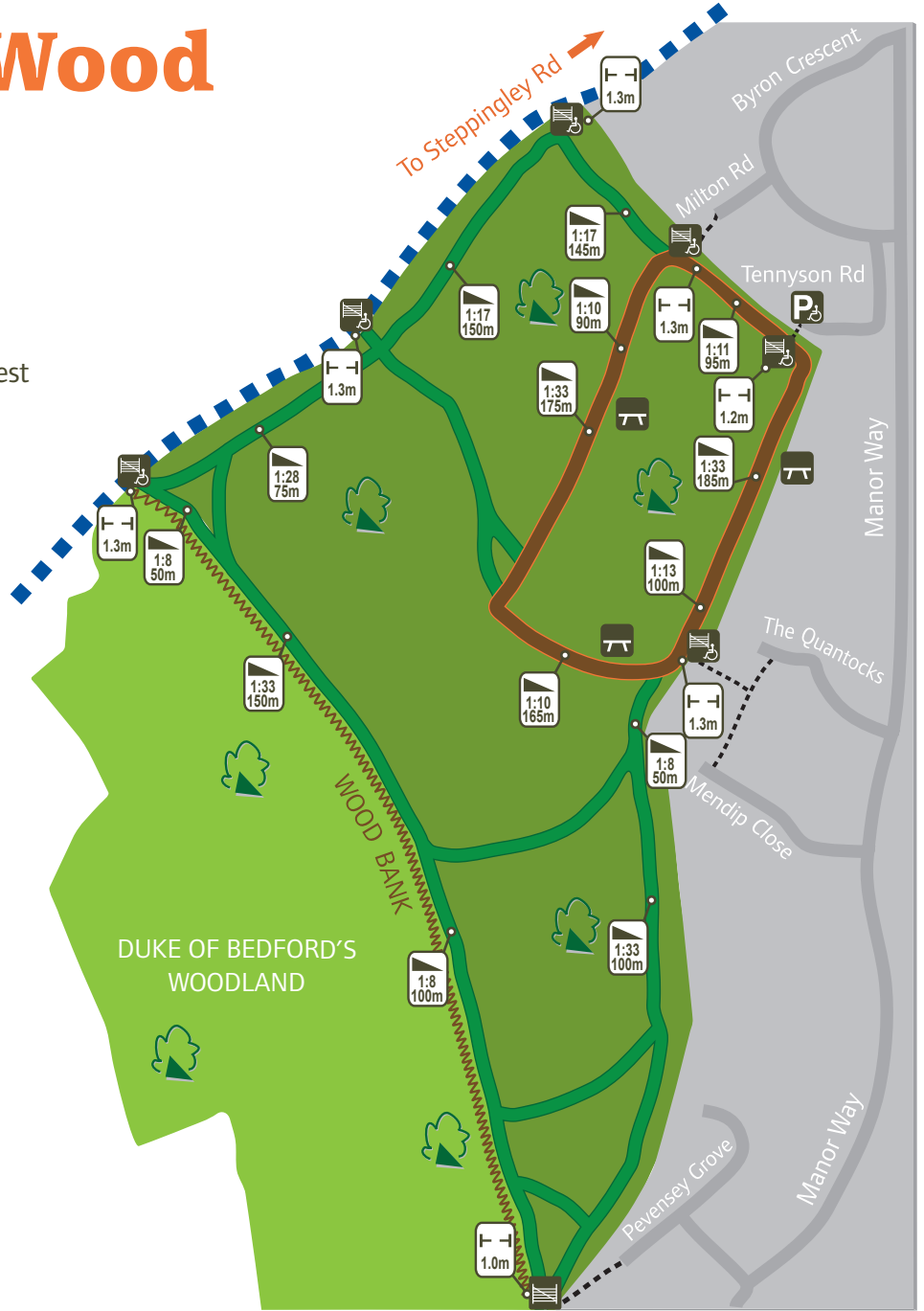
## Path surfaces

Path angles represent the steepest slope on any given path, other slopes may be present.

-  Surfaced path with some loose stones up to 20mm.
-  Only possible on foot. Natural earth path, can be uneven and muddy when wet, with prominent tree roots.

## Distances

Circuit of surfaced path = approx. 600m
