CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (HAYNES: FOOTPATH NO 22) PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2018

The above Order made on 13 April 2018 under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 will extinguish Footpath No 22, Haynes as shown on the Order map.

That length of Footpath No 22, Haynes to be stopped up extends from its junction with Church End Road at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0891 4110 (Order map - point E) in a southerly direction across the garden of the property known as Silver Birches for approximately 76 metres to OS GR TL 0892 4103 (Order map - point B) where it has a junction with Bridleway 19, Haynes. The footpath is stopped up over its full width.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of the Highway Assets Team, Central Bedfordshire Council, Priory House, Monks Walk, Chicksands, Shefford between 9.00am and 5.00pm on Mondays to Thursdays and between 9.00am to 4.00pm on Fridays. Copies of the Order and map may be bought there at a charge of £4.00. An explanatory statement can be obtained by phoning 0300 300 6888. Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Senior LSG Officer, Central Bedfordshire Council, Highways, Priory House, Monks Walk, Chicksands, Shefford, SG17 5QT not later than 25 May 2018. Please state the grounds on which they are made. Representations and objections must include either a postal or e-mail address. Any representations or objections made will be in the public domain and will be available for viewing/copying by members of the public.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn the Central Bedfordshire Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order and will be made publicly available by either the Council or the Planning Inspectorate.
