



Central Bedfordshire Council Notice of Making of Public Path Order Highways Act 1980

CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (HAYNES: FOOTPATH NO 4) PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2017

The above Order made on 8 December 2017 under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 will extinguish Footpath No 4, Haynes as shown on the Order map.

That length of Footpath No 4, Haynes to be stopped up extends from its junction with Plummers Lane and Silver End Road at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0974 4199 (Map point A) in a westerly direction along The Carriage Drive for approximately 35 metres to OS GR TL 0971 4200 (Map point B) and then continues in a south south westerly direction for approximately 58 metres to its junction with Park Palings Walk and another part of Footpath No. 4, Haynes at OS GR TL 0970 4194 (Map point C). The footpath is stopped up over its full width.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of the Highway Assets Team, Central Bedfordshire Council, Priory House, Monks Walk, Chicksands, Shefford between 9.00am and 5.00pm on Mondays to Thursdays and between 9.00am to 4.00pm on Fridays. Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Senior Definitive Map Officer, Highways Assets Team, Central Bedfordshire Council, Priory House, Monks Walk, Chicksands, Shefford, SG17 5QT not later than 19 January 2018. Please state the grounds on which they are made. Representations and objections must include either a postal or e-mail address. Any representations or objections made will be in the public domain and will be available for viewing/copying by members of the public.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn the Central Bedfordshire Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order and will be made publicly available by either the Council or the Planning Inspectorate.
