Notice of Confirmation of Modification Order  
Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

Definitive Map and Statement for the former Ampthill Urban and Rural Districts as at  
12 November 2004

THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BEDFORDSHIRE (DEFINITIVE MAP AND  
STATEMENT FOR BEDFORDSHIRE) (HAYNES: PART OF BRIDLEWAY NO 7)  
MODIFICATION ORDER 2007

On 27 July 2007 the County Council of Bedfordshire confirmed the above-named  
Order without modification.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to modify the definitive map and statement  
for the area by:

adding to them part of Bridleway No 7 Haynes which extends from its junction with  
Northwood End Road, Haynes at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL  
1031 4180 (Order map – point A) in a south westerly direction along a track through  
Hill Farm for approx 59 metres to OS GR TL 1027 4176 (Order map – point B) where  
it has a junction with another part of Bridleway No 7 Haynes.  
The new length of bridleway has a width of 5 metres.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at the offices of  
Countryside Access Services, Bedfordshire County Council, County Hall, Cauldwell  
Street, Bedford and may be inspected free of charge between 9.00am and 5.00pm  
on Mondays to Thursdays and between 9.00am and 4.00pm on Fridays. Copies of  
the Order and map may be purchased.

The Order came into force on 27 July 2007, but if a person aggrieved by the Order  
wants to question its validity, or any provision contained in it on the ground that it is  
not within the powers of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 or on the ground that  
any requirement of the Act or of any regulation made under the Act has not been  
complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 12(1) of  
Schedule 15 to the Act within 6 weeks from 3 August 2007 make an application to  
the High Court.
