Central Bedfordshire Council Notice of Confirmation of Public Path Order Highways Act 1980

CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (HENLOW: PART OF FOOTPATH NO 18) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2017

On the 5 May 2017 Central Bedfordshire Council confirmed the above Order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the following length of public Footpath No 18, Henlow as shown on the Order map.

The length of Footpath No 18, Henlow to be stopped up extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 1754 3884 (Map point B) in a north westerly direction for approximately 130 metres to OS GR TL 1746 3894 (Map point A).

The length of Footpath No 18, Henlow to be created extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 1754 3884 (Map point B) in a north westerly direction for approximately 133 metres to OS GR TL 1745 3892 (Map point C) and then continues in a north easterly direction for approximately 15 metres to OS GR TL 1746 3894 (Map point A).

The new route of the footpath has a width of 2 metres

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of Central Bedfordshire Council Highways, Priory House, Monks Walk, Chicksands, Shefford SG17 5QT between 9.00am and 5.00pm Mondays to Thursdays and between 9.00am to 4.00pm Fridays. Copies of the Order and map may be bought there at a charge of £4.00.

The Order comes into force on 26 May 2017, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 12 May 2017 make an application to the High Court.
