Central Bedfordshire Council Notice of Confirmation of Public Path Order Highways Act 1980

CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (HOUGHTON REGIS: PART OF BRIDLEWAY NO 49) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2016

On the 30 November 2018 Central Bedfordshire Council confirmed the above Order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the following lengths of public Bridleway No 49, Houghton Regis as shown on the Order map.

The first length of Bridleway No 49, Houghton Regis to be stopped up extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0000 2426 (Map point A) in a east north easterly direction for approximately 58 metres to its junction with Footpath No 57, Houghton Regis at OS GR TL 0005 2428 (Map point B) and then continues in a north north westerly direction for approximately 9 metres to OS GR TL 0004 2429 (Map point C).

The second length of Bridleway No 49, Houghton Regis to be stopped up extends from OS GR SP 9995 2447 (Map point D) in a north north westerly direction for approximately 16 metres to its junction with Thorn Road at OS GR SP 9994 2448 (Map point E).

The first length of Bridleway No 49, Houghton Regis to be created extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0000 2426 (Map point A) in a generally east north easterly direction across the vehicle access road for approximately 59 metres to its junction with Footpath No 57 and an unaffected part of Bridleway No 49, Houghton Regis at OS GR TL 0004 2429 (Map point C).

The second length of Bridleway No 49, Houghton Regis to be created extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) SP 9995 2447 (Map point D) in a generally east north easterly and then north north westerly direction for approximately 38 metres to its new junction with Thorn Road at OS GR SP 9997 2449 (Map point F).

The new routes of the bridleway have a width of 4 metres.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of Central Bedfordshire Council Highways, Priory House, Monks Walk, Chicksands, Shefford SG17 5QT between 9.00am and 5.00pm Mondays to Thursdays and between 9.00am to 4.00pm Fridays. Copies of the Order and map may be bought there at a charge of £4.00.

The Order comes into force on the date on which Central Bedfordshire Council certify that the public footpath described in Article 2 of the Order has been set out to their satisfaction, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 6 December 2018 make an application to the High Court.
