CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (MAULDEN: FOOTPATH NO 28) PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2013

The above Order made on 17 May 2013 under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 will extinguish Footpath No 28, Maulden as shown on the Order map.

That length of Footpath No 28, Maulden to be stopped up extends from its junction with Bridleway No 24 Maulden at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0763 3772 (Map point A) in a generally southerly direction for approximately 153 metres to OS GR TL 0765 3757 (Map point B) where it has a junction with Clophill Road, Maulden.

The footpath is stopped up over its full width.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of Countryside Access Team, Central Bedfordshire Council, Technology House, Ampthill Road, Bedford between 9.00am and 5.00pm on Mondays to Thursdays and between 9.00am to 4.00pm on Fridays. Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Orders and Commons Registration Officer, Countryside Access Team, Central Bedfordshire Council, Technology House, Ampthill Road, Bedford MK42 9BD not later than 28 June 2013. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn the Central Bedfordshire Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
