In terms of finances they have a sponsorship deal in place for this season 2018/2019 however there is an agreement that half of this money goes to the clubs academy/children (u6s to u16s) the remaining amount to put towards the ground/floodlights.

They do not know whether the sponsorship deal will be available for the 2019/20 season.
