Payment Refund Contact

Attempts to obtain school bank account details in order to take refunds of unpaid monies.

NAFN has recently been advised by a member local authority that one of their schools has been the target of an attempted fraudulent refund.

The school received a payment remittance from The Education Broker, a company with which they have no record of any previous dealings. Later that day, the school received a telephone call explaining that the monies and the remittance had been sent as a result of a technical fault. The caller requested a copy of the remittance and the schools bank details in order to resolve the issue.

The school were not expecting any payment from The Education Broker and the details of the Head Teacher noted on the remittance were incorrect. Due to this, the person who took the call was suspicious and did not provide any information.

The initial payment specified on the remittance was never actually received by the school and as no information was provided to the caller, no loss was suffered.

NAFN would like to remind our members to exercise caution when presented with correspondence of this kind to ensure that correct processes are followed and the requestor's details are legitimate. This type of scam has previously been circulated to members (INTAL047).
