# Biggleswade Riverside Path

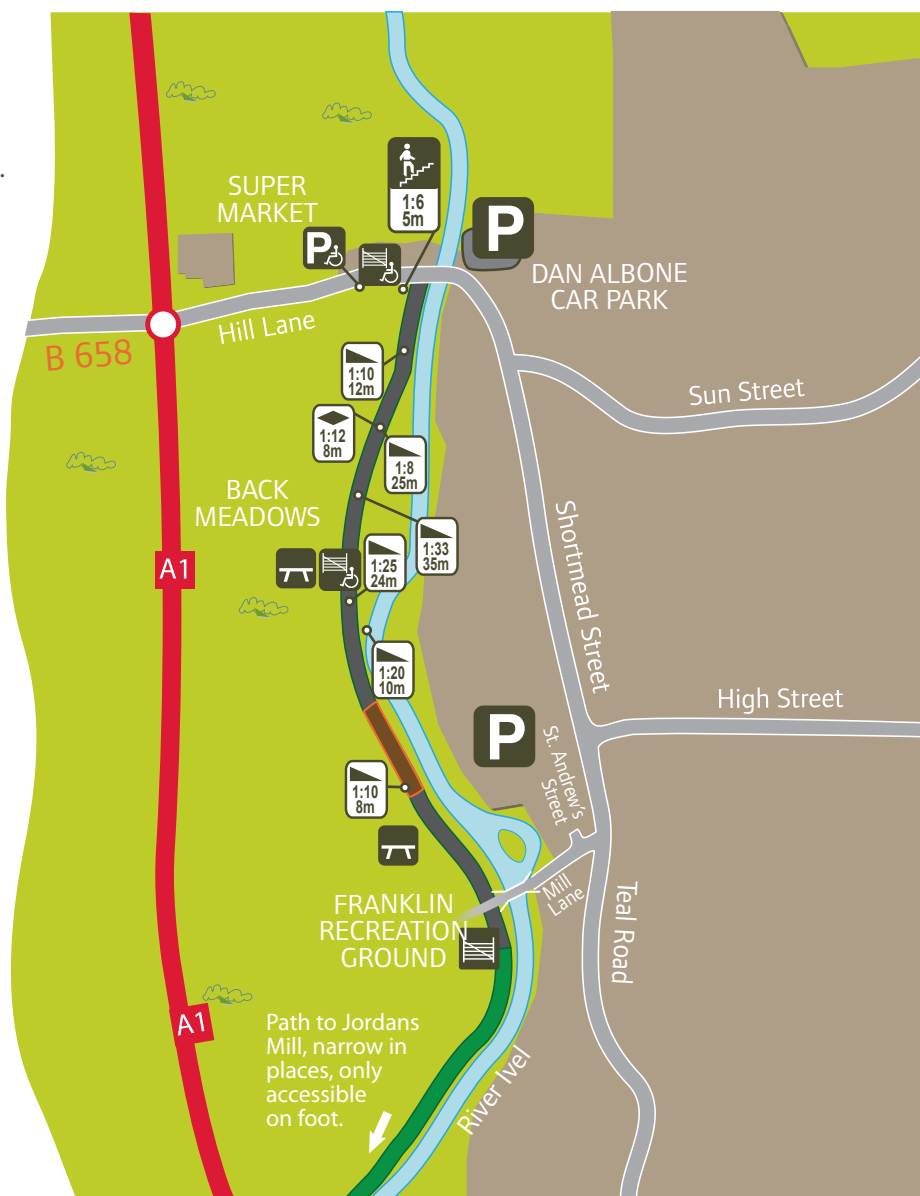
## Path surfaces

Path angles represent the  
steepest slope on any given  
path, other slopes may be present.

-  Surfaced path. Bumpy in places with some loose stones up to 30mm.
-  Only accessible on foot grass path, can be uneven and very narrow.
-  Tarmac path

## Distances

Circular path from Hill Lane to Mill Lane, along river and back along St. Andrew's and Shortmead Street = 1.8km.
