Notice of Confirmation of Public Path Order
Highways Act 1980

CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (SILSOE: PART OF FOOTPATH NO 17) PUBLIC
PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2012

On 27th April 2012 the Central Bedfordshire Council confirmed the above Order made under
Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert part of public Footpath No 17, Silsoe as
shown on the Order map.

The length of Footpath No 17 Silsoe to be stopped up extends from another section of
Footpath No 17 Silsoe at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0807 3369 (Order
map - point A) over a grass field in a south easterly direction for approx 161 metres to OS
GR TL 0821 3361 (Order map - point B).

The new route of Footpath No 17 Silsoe extends from another section of Footpath No 17
Silsoe at OS GR TL 0807 3369 (Order map - point A) over a grass field and alongside a
fence in an east north easterly direction for approx 87 metres to OS GR TL 0794 3645 and
then continues alongside the fence in a south south easterly direction for approx 133 metres
to another part of Footpath No 17 Silsoe at OS GR TL 0821 3361 (Order map - point B).

The new route of the footpath has a width of 2 metres

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the Order map have been placed and may be seen
free of charge at the offices of Countryside Access Team, Central Bedfordshire Council,
Technology House, Ampthill Road, Bedford between 9.00am and 5.00pm Mondays to
Thursdays and between 9.00am to 4.00pm Fridays. Copies of the Order and map may be
bought there.

The Order comes into force on the date on which Central Bedfordshire Council certify that
the public footpath described in Article 2 of the Order has been set out to their satisfaction,
but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision
contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as
amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to
the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by
paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 3rd May 2012 make an application
to the High Court.
