CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (BEDFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DISTRICT OF SOUTH BEDFORDSHIRE) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA AND SPECIAL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2008) (VARIATION NO.44) ORDER 2016

The Central Bedfordshire Council (the "Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 18th day of April 2016 and may be cited as "Central Bedfordshire Council (Bedfordshire County Council (District of South Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008) (Variation No.44) Order 2016"
- 2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into operation, the provisions of the "Bedfordshire County Council (District of South Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008" shall be varied as follows:-

To add No Waiting at any time on the following lengths of road in Dunstable:-

- (i) Duncombe Drive, west side, from the north kerb line of Katherine Drive extending in a northerly direction for approximately 15 metres.
- (ii) Duncombe Drive, east side, from the north kerb line of Katherine Drive extending in a northerly direction for approximately 70 metres.
- (iii) Beech Road, north-west side, from a point approximately 5 metres south-west of the rear wall of no.551 Lowther Road extending in a south-westerly direction for approximately 40 metres.
- (iv) Lowther Road, both sides, from the south-west kerb line of Beech Road extending in a north-westerly direction for approximately 10 metres.
- (v) Chiltern Road, north-west side, from a point approximately 44 metres south-west of its junction with High Street North extending in a south-westerly direction to a point in line with the property boundary of Eliott Court and no.1 The Parade, Chiltern Road.
- (vi) King Street, north-west side, from its junction with High Street South service road extending in a north-easterly direction to a point approximately 3 metres north-east of the front wall of the Star and Garter public house, 147 High Street North.
- (vii) High Street North, north-west side, from its junction with King Street extending in a north-west direction to a point approximately 3 metres north-west of the south-east flank wall of the Star and Garter public house, 147 High Street North.
- (viii) Maidenbower Avenue, south-west side, from a point in line with the boundary of nos.20 and 22 Maidenbower Avenue extending in a north-westerly direction to a point in line with the south-east flank wall of no.17 Maidenbower Avenue.
- (ix) Loring Road, both sides, from the south-east kerb line of Maidenbower Avenue extending in a south-westerly direction for approximately 19 metres.

To add No Waiting at any time on the following lengths of road in Kensworth:-

- (i) Common Road, south side, from a point in line with the front wall of no.1 The Chilterns extending in a westerly direction for approximately 33 metres.
- (ii) The Chilterns, east side, from its junction with Common Road extending in a southerly direction to a point in line with the property boundary of nos.2 and 3 The Chilterns.
- (iii) The Chilterns, west side, from its junction with Common Road extending in a southerly direction to a point approximately 11 metres south of the property boundary of nos.1 and 2 The Chilterns.

To add No Waiting Monday to Friday 8.00am to 4.30pm on the following length of road in Dunstable:-

(i) Beech Road, north-west side, from a point approximately 6 metres north-east of the property boundary of nos.1 and 3 Beech Road (termination of existing double yellow lines) extending in a south-westerly direction to a point approximately 5 metres south-west of the rear wall of no.551 Lowther Road.
