## CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (STOTFOLD: PART OF FOOTPATH NO 7) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2016

The above Order made on 29 April 2016 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert Footpath No 7, Stotfold as shown on the Order map.

The length of Footpath No 7, Stotfold to be stopped up extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 2192 3767 (Map point B) in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 139 metres to its junction with Taylors Road at OS GR TL 2180 3774 (Map point A).

The length of Footpath No 7, Stotfold to be created extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 2193 3768 (Map point D) in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 147 metres to its junction with Aspen Gardens and Taylors Road at OS GR TL 2181 3757 (Map point C).

The new route of the footpath has a width of 1.8 metres

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of Rights of Way Team, Central Bedfordshire Council, Priory House, Monks Walk, Chicksands, Shefford between 9.00am and 5.00pm on Mondays to Thursdays and between 9.00am to 4.00pm on Fridays. Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Senior GIS Officer, Rights of Way Team, Central Bedfordshire Council, Priory House, Monks Walk, Chicksands, Shefford, SG17 5QT not later than 17 June 2016. Please state the grounds on which they are made. Representations and objections must include either a postal or e-mail address. Any representations or objections made will be in the public domain and will be available for viewing/copying by members of the public.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn the Central Bedfordshire Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order and will be made publicly available by either the Council or the Planning Inspectorate.
