Notice of Confirmation of Modification Order Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

Definitive Map and Statement for Central Bedfordshire Council as at10 October 2014

CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT FOR CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE) (TODDINGTON: FOOTPATH NO 101) MODIFICATION ORDER 2017

On 4 August 2017 the Central Bedfordshire Council confirmed the above-named Order without modification.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding to them the following length of footpath:

The length of Footpath No 101, Toddington to be added extends from its junction with Workhouse Lane, Toddington at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0083 2843 (Order map – point A) in a generally westerly direction for approximately 10 metres and then in a south westerly direction for approximately 12 metres to OS GR TL 0082 2842 and then extends in a generally westerly direction for approximately 32 metres to terminate at the eastern edge of the turning head off Lakefield Avenue at OS GR TL 0079 2842 (Order map – point B).

The Footpath has a width of 2.0 metres at the bollards at OS GR TL 0083 2843 (Order map – point A) and then has a width of 1.5 metres between from a point just west of the bollards and OS GR TL 0079 2842 (Order map – point B).

Limitations:

A row of bollards at OS GR TL 0083 2843 (Order map - point A).

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at the offices of Central Bedfordshire Council Highways, Priory House, Monks Walk, Chicksands, Shefford SG17 5QT and may be inspected free of charge between 9.00am and 5.00pm on Mondays to Thursdays and between 9.00am and 4.00pm on Fridays. Copies of the Order and map may be purchased there at a charge of £4.00.

The Order comes into force on 4 August 2017 but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 12(1) of Schedule 15 to the Act within 6 weeks from 10 August 2017 make an application to the High Court.
