Definitive Map and Statement for as at

CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT FOR CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE) (TODDINGTON: FOOTPATH NO 101) MODIFICATION ORDER 2017

The above Order made on 2 June 2017, if confirmed as made will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding to them the following length of footpath:

The length of Footpath No 101, Toddington to be added extends from its junction with Workhouse Lane, Toddington at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0083 2843 (Order map – point A) in a generally westerly direction for approximately 10 metres and then in a south westerly direction for approximately 12 metres to OS GR TL 0082 2842 and then extends in a generally westerly direction for approximately 32 metres to terminate at the eastern edge of the turning head off Lakefield Avenue at OS GR TL 0079 2842 (Order map – point B).

The Footpath has a width of 2.0 metres at the bollards at OS GR TL 0083 2843 (Order map – point A) and then has a width of 1.5 metres between from a point just west of the bollards and OS GR TL 0079 2842 (Order map – point B).

Limitations:

A row of bollards at OS GR TL 0083 2843 (Order map – point A).

A copy of the Order and the map may be seen free of charge at the offices of Central Bedfordshire Council Highways, Priory House, Monks Walk, Chicksands, Shefford between 9.00am and 5.00pm on Mondays to Thursdays and between 9.00am and 4.00pm on Fridays. Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to the Senior Definitive Map Officer, Central Bedfordshire Council, Priory House, Monks Walk, Chicksands, Shefford, SG17 5QT not later than 21 July 2017, and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made. Representations and objections must include either a postal or e-mail address. Any representations or objections made will be in the public domain and will be available for viewing/copying by members of the public.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn the Central Bedfordshire Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order and will be made publicly available by either the Council or the Planning Inspectorate.
