Central Bedfordshire Council Notice of Making of Public Path Order Highways Act 1980

CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (TODDINGTON: PART OF FOOTPATH NO A62) PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2016

The above Order made on 15 April 2016 under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 will extinguish Footpath No A62, Toddington as shown on the Order map.

That length of Footpath No A62, Toddington to be stopped up extends from its junction with Dunstable Road at the north eastern corner of No 2, Dunstable Road, Toddington at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference TL 0089 2844 (Map point A) in a south south westerly direction for approximately 93 metres to a point in the rear garden of No 38, Dunstable Road, Toddington at OS GR TL 0084 2835 (Map point B).

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of Rights of Way Team, Central Bedfordshire Council, Priory House, Monks Walk, Chicksands, Shefford between 9.00am and 5.00pm on Mondays to Thursdays and between 9.00am to 4.00pm on Fridays. Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Senior GIS Officer, Rights of Way Team, Central Bedfordshire Council, Priory House, Monks Walk, Chicksands, Shefford, SG17 5QT not later than 27 May 2016. Please state the grounds on which they are made. Representations and objections must include either a postal or e-mail address. Any representations or objections made will be in the public domain and will be available for viewing/copying by members of the public.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn the Central Bedfordshire Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order and will be made publicly available by either the Council or the Planning Inspectorate.
