Highways Act 1980

CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (TODDINGTON: PART OF FOOTPATH NO A62) PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2016

On the 3 June 2016 Central Bedfordshire Council confirmed the above Order made under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to extinguish the following length of public Footpath No A62, Toddington as shown on the Order map.

That length of Footpath No A62, Toddington to be stopped up extends from its junction with Dunstable Road at the north eastern corner of No 2, Dunstable Road, Toddington at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference TL 0089 2844 (Map point A) in a south south westerly direction for approximately 93 metres to a point in the rear garden of No 38, Dunstable Road, Toddington at OS GR TL 0084 2835 (Map point B).

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of Rights of Way Team, Central Bedfordshire Council, Priory House, Monks Walk, Chicksands, Shefford SG17 5QT between 9.00am and 5.00pm Mondays to Thursdays and between 9.00am to 4.00pm Fridays. Copies of the Order and map may be bought there at a charge of £4.00.

The Order comes into force on 10 June 2016, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 9 June 2016 make an application to the High Court.
