(WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2008)  
(VARIATION NO. 17) ORDER 2011

The Central Bedfordshire Council (the "Council") in exercise of the powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on 3rd day of October 2011 and may be cited as "Central Bedfordshire Council (Bedfordshire County Council (District of Mid Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008) (Variation No. 17) Order 2011."
  
2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into operation, the provisions of the "Bedfordshire County Council (District of Mid Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008" shall be varied as follows:-
  - (i) The plan schedule reference "Area Code AX71: Sheet Revision Number — 1" shall be deleted from the plans attached to the Order and "Area Code AX71: Sheet Revision Number — 2" shall be substituted.  
  
The plan schedule reference "Area Code AW71 Sheet Revision Number — 1" shall be added to the plans attached to the Order.
  - (iii) The plan schedule reference "Area Code AX72 Sheet Revision Number — 1" shall be added to the plans attached to the Order.

On 23rd September 2011 Central Bedfordshire Council made a Road Traffic Regulation Order as follows:

Effect of the Order:

**To introduce No Stopping Monday to Friday from 8.00am to 4.30pm inclusive on the school entrance markings on the following lengths of road in Shefford:**

1. Bloomfield Drive, outside Robert Bloomfield Middle School.

**To introduce No Waiting At Any Time on the following lengths of road in Shefford:**

1. Ampthill Road, south side, from a point approximately 14.2 metres east of the centreline of School Lane in a westerly direction to a point approximately 15 metres west of the centreline of School Lane.
2. Ampthill Road, south side, from a point approximately 12.5 metres east of the centreline of Bloomfield Drive in a westerly direction to a point approximately 14.2 metres west of the centreline of Bloomfield Drive.
3. Bloomfield Drive, both sides, from the southern kerb line of Ampthill Road in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 15 metres.

**To introduce No Waiting Monday to Friday from 8.00am to 4.30pm on the following lengths of road in Shefford:**

1. Bloomfield Drive, west side, from a point approximately 15 metres south of the southern kerb line of Ampthill Road in a southerly direction to a point approximately 10 metres south of the boundary between property nos 16 and 18 Bloomfield Drive.
2. Bloomfield Drive, east side, from a point approximately 3.7 metres south of the boundary between property nos 7 and 9 Bloomfield Drive in southerly direction to a point approximately 9.4 metres west of the boundary between property nos 28 and 30 George Street.

**Note:- The Notice of Proposals that was published on 21st January 2011 included No Waiting At Any Time on both sides of School Lane, extending from Ampthill Road for a distance of 27.7 metres. This particular restriction will not be implemented at this time.**

Date of Operation: The Order will come into operation on the 3rd October 2011.

Further Details: of the Order and a plan may be examined during normal opening hours at Shefford Library, 1 High Street, Shefford, SG17 5DD.

High Court Challenge: Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant Section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the ground that any requirement of that Section had not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the 23rd September 2011 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
