The Central Bedfordshire Council (the "Council") in exercise of the powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on 21st day of January 2013 and may be cited as "Central Bedfordshire Council (Bedfordshire County Council (District of South Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008) (Variation No.19) Order 2013"
  
2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into operation, the provisions of the "Bedfordshire County Council (District of South Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008" shall be varied as follows:-
  - (i) The plan schedule reference "Area Code Y 138: Sheet Revision Number – 2" shall be deleted and "Area Code Y 138: Sheet Revision Number – 3" shall be substituted.
  - (ii) The plan schedule reference "Area Code Z 138: Sheet Revision Number – 1" shall be deleted and "Area Code Z 138: Sheet Revision Number – 2" shall be substituted.
  - (iii) The plan schedule reference "Area Code Z 137: Sheet Revision Number – 1" shall be deleted and "Area Code Z 137: Sheet Revision Number – 2" shall be substituted.

On 14th January 2013 Central Bedfordshire Council made a Road Traffic Regulation Order as follows:-

**To introduce a Restricted Parking Zone (no waiting and no loading/unloading) at any time on the following lengths of road in Dunstable:-**

1. Queensway, from its junction with Vernon Place in a south-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 22 metres when measured from the rear on the footway of Vernon Place.
2. Vernon Place, for its entire length, except for the length of road identified below as Limited Waiting.
3. Court Drive, for its entire length, except for the length of road identified below as a Prohibition of Stopping.
4. Kingsway, from its junction with College Drive to its junction with Court Drive
5. College Drive, from its junction with Kingsway in a north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 64 metres when measured from the rear of the footway of Kingsway.

**Limited Waiting for 30 minutes with no return within 1 hour on the following lengths of road in Dunstable:-**

Vernon Place, south-west side, from a point approximately 2 metres south-east of the south-east flank wall of property no.21 Vernon Place in a north-westerly direction to a point in line with the boundary of property nos.23 and 24 Vernon Place.

**Prohibition of Stopping except Buses from 5am to 10.30pm and Taxis from 10.30pm to 5am on the following lengths of road in Dunstable:-**

Court Drive, south-east side, from a point approximately 28 metres north-east of the south-west flank wall of The Gary Cooper public house in a south-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 87 metres.

Date of Operation:- The Order will come into operation on the 21st January 2013.

Further Details of the Order and a plan may be examined during normal opening hours at Dunstable Library, Vernon Place, Dunstable LU5 4HA.

High Court Challenge:- Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant Section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the ground that any requirement of that Section had not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of 14th January 2013, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
