

CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (BEDFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DISTRICT OF SOUTH BEDFORDSHIRE) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA AND SPECIAL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2008) (VARIATION NO.26) ORDER 2014

On 24 February 2014 Central Bedfordshire Council made the above named Traffic Regulation Order as follows:-

To remove the existing No Waiting Mon-Sat, 7am-7pm (single yellow lines) on the following lengths of road in Leighton Buzzard:-

North Street, south-east side, from a point in line with the north flank wall of no.90 North Street extending in a north-easterly direction to a point in line with the north-east flank wall of no.90a North Street.

To introduce 30 minutes Limited Waiting Mon-Sat, 8am-6pm, No Return within 2 hours, on the following lengths of road in Leighton Buzzard:-

North Street, south-east side, from a point in line with the south flank wall of no.90a North Street extending in north-easterly direction to a point in line with the north-east flank wall of no.90a North Street.

To amend the existing 2 hours Limited Waiting Mon-Sat 8am-6pm, No Return within 2 hours, to 30 minutes Limited Waiting Mon-Sat 8am-6pm, No Return within 2 hours, on the following lengths of road in Leighton Buzzard:-

North Street, east side, from a point in line with the north flank wall of no.90 North Street extending in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 46 metres.

Date of Operation:- The Orders will come into operation on the 3 March 2014.

Further Details may be examined during normal opening hours at Leighton Buzzard Library, Lake Street, Leighton Buzzard LU7 1RX.

High Court Challenge:- Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant Section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the ground that any requirement of that Section had not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of 24 February 2014, make application for the purpose to the High Court.


The Central Bedfordshire Council (the "Council") in exercise of the powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on 3rd day of March 2014 and may be cited as "Central Bedfordshire Council (Bedfordshire County Council (District of South Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008) (Variation No.26) Order 2014"

2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into operation, the provisions of the "Bedfordshire County Council (District of South Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008" shall be varied as follows:-
 - (i) The plan schedule reference "Area Code F 125: Sheet Revision Number – 3" shall be deleted and "Area Code F 125: Sheet Revision Number – 4" shall be substituted.
 - (ii) The plan schedule reference "Area Code W 137: Sheet Revision Number – 1" shall be deleted and "Area Code W 137: Sheet Revision Number – 2" shall be substituted.
 - (iii) The plan schedule reference "Area Code X 137: Sheet Revision Number – 2" shall be deleted and "Area Code X 137: Sheet Revision Number – 3" shall be substituted.
 - (iv) The plan schedule reference "Area Code W 136: Sheet Revision Number – 1" shall be added to the plans attached to this Order.
