On the 3rd July 2009 Central Bedfordshire Council made a Road Traffic Regulation Order as follows:

Effect of the Order:

**A. To introduce No Waiting Monday to Friday inclusive 8.30am – 9.30am and 2.30pm - 4.00pm on Highfield Road, Leighton Buzzard:-**

On the east side of Highfield Road, Leighton Buzzard which extends from a point 4 metres south east of the boundary of 73 / 75 Highfield Road in a generally north westerly direction for a distance of approx 48 metres.

**B. To Introduce No Stopping Monday to Friday inclusive from 8am – 4.30pm on the School Entrance Markings on Highfield Road, Leighton Buzzard:-**

On the west side of Highfield Road, Leighton Buzzard which extends from the boundary of 64 / 66 Highfield Road in a generally north westerly direction for a distance of approx 43.56 metres.

**C. Introduce no waiting at any time on Soulbury Road, Linslade:-**

Soulbury Road, Linslade: Both sides from a point 39 metres north west of its junction with Springfield Road to a point 2 metres north west of the property boundary of Nos 27 and 27a Soulbury Road.

Date of Operation: The Order came into operation on the 6th July 2009.

Further Details of the Order and a plan showing the length of road affected may be examined during normal opening hours at Leighton Buzzard Library, Lake Street, Leighton Buzzard.

High Court Challenge: Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant Section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the ground that any requirement of that Section had not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the 8th July 2009 make application for the purpose to the High Court.

## BEDFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL PROPOSES TO INTRODUCE WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND NO STOPPING IN HIGHFIELD ROAD, LEIGHTON BUZZARD.

Reason for proposal: The proposed Order is considered necessary on the grounds of promoting road safety. The restrictions are specifically aimed at controlling on-street parking in the vicinity of Leedon Lower School, Leighton Buzzard. It is proposed to extend the existing 'School Keep Clear' marking and introduce a single yellow line on the opposite side of Highfield Road to further increase safety and prevent obstruction outside the School.

Therefore, Bedfordshire County Council proposes to make a Road Traffic Regulation Order as follows:

### **B. To Introduce No Stopping Monday to Friday inclusive from 8am – 4.30pm on the School Entrance Markings on the following length of road:-**

On the west side of Highfield Road, Leighton Buzzard which extends from the boundary of 64 / 66 Highfield Road in a generally north westerly direction for a distance of approx 43.56 metres.

1. This Order shall come into operation on 6th day of July 2009 and may be cited as "Central Bedfordshire Council (Bedfordshire County Council (District of South Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008 (Variation No 7) Order 2009"
  
2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into operation, the provisions of the "Bedfordshire County Council (District of South Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008" shall be varied as follows:-
  - (i) The plan schedule reference "Area Code D 125: Sheet Revision Number – 2" shall be deleted and "Area Code D 125: Sheet Revision Number – 3" shall be substituted.
  
  - (ii) The plan schedule reference "Area Code I 127: Sheet Revision Number – 1" shall be deleted and "Area Code I 127: Sheet Revision Number – 2" shall be substituted.

**STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR THE MAKING OF A TRAFFIC  
REGULATION ORDER TO INTRODUCE WAITING RESTRICTIONS  
AND NO STOPPING IN HIGHFIELD ROAD, LEIGHTON BUZZARD.**

## **INTRODUCTION**

Bedfordshire County Council has drawn up a proposal to make a Traffic Regulation Order to introduce waiting restrictions and No Stopping in Highfield Road, Leighton Buzzard.

## **LENGTHS OF ROADS CONCERNED**

### **A. To introduce No Waiting Monday to Friday inclusive 8.30am – 9.30am and 2.30pm - 4.00pm on the following length of road:-**

On the east side of Highfield Road, Leighton Buzzard which extends from a point 4 metres south east of the boundary of 73 / 75 Highfield Road in a generally north westerly direction for a distance of approx 48 metres.

### **B. To Introduce No Stopping Monday to Friday inclusive from 8am – 4.30pm on the School Entrance Markings on the following length of road:-**

On the west side of Highfield Road, Leighton Buzzard which extends from the boundary of 64 / 66 Highfield Road in a generally north westerly direction for a distance of approx 43.56 metres.
