CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, EAST DUNSTABLE) (WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2018

CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Bedfordshire in accordance with paragraph 20 of Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on the 5th day of February 2018 and may be cited as "Central Bedfordshire Council (Various Roads, East Dunstable) (Weight Restriction) Order 2018.
- Any previous Weight Restriction Orders made on the lengths of road specified in the schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, drive or cause to be driven any heavy commercial goods vehicle the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes on the lengths of road described in the Schedule to this Order (hereinafter referred to as "the said lengths of road").
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from driving any vehicle on the said lengths of road if the vehicle is being used:-
 - (a) for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (b) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to the said lengths of road;
 - (c) in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic in the said lengths of road;

(d) in connection with the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road;

(e) in connection with the laying erection alteration or repair in or adjacent to the said lengths of road of any sewer or any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas water electricity or telecommunications;

(f) for agricultural purposes in connection with land within the area defined in the Schedule to this Order;

(g) for purposes of access for unloading and loading and garaging of vehicles;

(h) for public service vehicle purposes;

in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

(j) in connection with local driver training or testing;

(k) for the purposes of using symbol signed diversion routes approved by the highway authority and having been brought into operation by the police or approved highway authority personnel.

SCHEDULE

Lengths of Roads in Dunstable

All of those roads, contained within an area bounded by, but not including, the following:-

- a) In the north and east, an imaginary line from a point in Poynters Road, Dunstable immediately south-east of Porz Avenue extending south-eastwards to the north-east of Poynters Road crossing Brunel Road and continuing to a point immediately west of Leagrave High Street, then crossing to the south of Poynters Road and continuing south eastwards to a point immediately north of the A505 Luton Road at its junction with Poynters Road Dunstable..
- b) In the south, A505 Luton Road, Dunstable.
- c) In the west, an imaginary line from a point in Ridgeway Avenue, Dunstable immediately north of A505 Luton Road, Dunstable extending northwards to the west of Ridgeway Avenue and eastwards to the north of Wilbury Drive to a point immediately west of Poynters Road, Dunstable and extending north-westwards to the south-west of Poynters Road to a point in Poynters Road immediately south-east of Porz Avenue.
